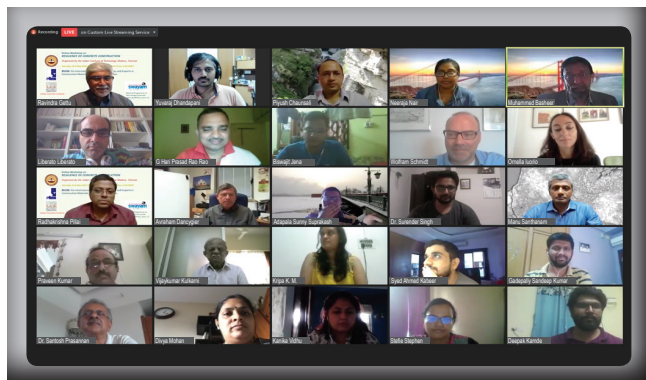

Online Workshop on "Resilience of Concrete Construction"

RILEM Online Conferences & Transfer of Knowledge (ROC&TOK)

Saturday 23rd May

The second workshop of the brand-new series of ONLINE events called RILEM Online Conferences & Transfer of Knowledge (ROC&TOK) took place on 23rd May 2020. The workshop, organised by IIT Madras Construction Materials Group and co-sponsored by RILEM, dealt with advances about improvement in the response of the construction industry to extreme global and local events, such as earthquakes, floods, hurricanes and cyclones.

The workshop had 11 speakers delivering lectures on a range of themes related to resilience in construction. The workshop was attended by graduate students, researchers, practising engineers and industry experts around the world, with about 3000 registered participants. The workshop was held on Zoom and live streamed on YouTube, where it has more than 5000 views already.
